Approval of minutes from July 12, 2023, Carolyn S., Secretary:

Some minor adjustments were made in the preliminary minutes after it was initially distributed. The vast majority of those were to correct the names of the members in attendance.

Treasurer's Report, Bob C.:

Balance in Checking on 9/11/23: \$ 8112.14

Balance in Savings: \$19696.06

Big expenses coming up - paying speakers for the Retreat, paying the Twin Rocks facility fees and the Region 1 Assembly/Convention for one rep. Since the Retreat just ended, it has not been possible yet to compile a comprehensive list yet of final expenses.

Budget 2024 - Jean H. and Dorothy C. volunteered to help create a preliminary budget for 2024. This will be discussed in our October meeting and voted on in our November meeting. (NOTE: We will be taking December off, which means the next two meetings are critical to create our future budget.)

We are currently spending \$300+ a year on the INFO Line for a cell phone. Since our previous volunteer has stepped down from this position, this expense is not creating value to our fellowship. We are, therefore, looking for someone else to take on this service position. This is an easy job, normally averaging only approximately two calls a month. We elected Martha J. as a Special Delegate for next month's Region 1 Assembly 2023. This was necessary because Lisa S., our regular delegate, also holds the position of secretary for Region 1. It would be impossible for her to cover the responsibilities of both positions at the same event

Serenity Retreat Report: Leanne M.:

Huge kudos to all the Serenity Retreat volunteers for putting on such a successful event. They include Nicole S., Registrar; Laurie M., Volunteer Coordinator; Allison G., Arts & Crafts; Beverly M., Speaker Coordinator; Jenice G. and Jan E., general volunteers. It's not quite over for you folk... debriefing of your work at the retreat is coming up shortly.

Although we have yet to send out a retreat survey for attendees, the feedback so far has been very positive. We had 68 people register, and 61 people attended. This is comparable to the attendance we enjoyed at retreats prior to Covid. Ten of those in attendance were new-comers using the \$50 special rate. Two of those newbies said that they so enjoyed the event, they would have paid full price if needed. Donations for our literature, various OA supplies and the

used clothing exchange provided us with \$200. Handouts for speakers will be sent to all who attended.

Once we have a final accounting, we can decide if we want to do it again. However, Twin Rocks has a first come, first serve policy about booking dates. Since the September retreat in the last two years has been so successful, we passed a motion to put a deposit on this date for next year. If we decide otherwise, we hope that the deposit will be returned in full.
